➢ NPCCHH program is very vast, needs involvement of multiple sectors, and implementation of multipronged strategies to reduce impact of climate change on human health.

- ➤Training Modules covering all important aspects of the program like Cold wave advisory / management protocols should be made available
- ➢There should be different modules for various cadres of health sector- Module for Community level Training for Impacts of Air Pollution is made available, there should be a module for staff of Health Facilities like Medical Officers also
- Structured monitoring mechanism should be strongly advocated by the Centrewhat is monitored is performed
- ➢ District Collectors are expected to monitor the program during regular review of Health Department but the program is assigned low priority.
