- More man power should be involved in order to run the Programme smoothly, as of now only two persons were nominated to take charge the Climate Change Programme i.e., State Entomologist (IDSP) & State Accountant (TB).

STATE PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION ON CLIMATE CHANGE & HUMAN HEALTH, MEGHALAYA, 2020-2021

- Due to Covid-19 crisis only few activities has been done in our State on Climate Change Programme.
- In this regards I would like to share below few activities what we have done in our State for the month of March and April 2021:-
 1. The Post of Consultant Climate Change has been assigned to the State Entomologist IDSP on February, 2021, to take charge all activities related to Climate Change.
 2. The last review meeting was held on March, 2021 at NHM conference hall chaired by Mission Director and State Nodal Officer Climate Change to discuss the plan activities for Climate Change Programme to be conducted in the month of March, 2021.
 3. The total amount 3 lakhs has been approved as committed expenditure through note sheet for conducting activities for the month of March, 2021 i.e. one lakh has been approved under budget heads of IEC & BCC and other two lakhs under Sensitization Workshop/meetings of the state and districts Health Department officers on Climate change and Human Health (FY:2019-2020).
 4. Designing and Printing of IEC materials on Air Pollution, Impact of Climate Change on Human Health and How Climate Change affect Vector Borne Diseases has been done (500 Nos.) in the month of April, 2021.
 5. One day training at the State level has been conducted to District Medical and Health Officer on the topic “Impact of Climate Change on Human Health” held on 14th April, 2021.
 6. The training of the Medical officers and Health Staffs in selected CHCs and PHCs about Impact of Climate Change & Human Health has been conducted from 21st April, 2021 and completed on 30th April, 2021.
 7. Spot mapping has been done in selected CHCs and PHCs.

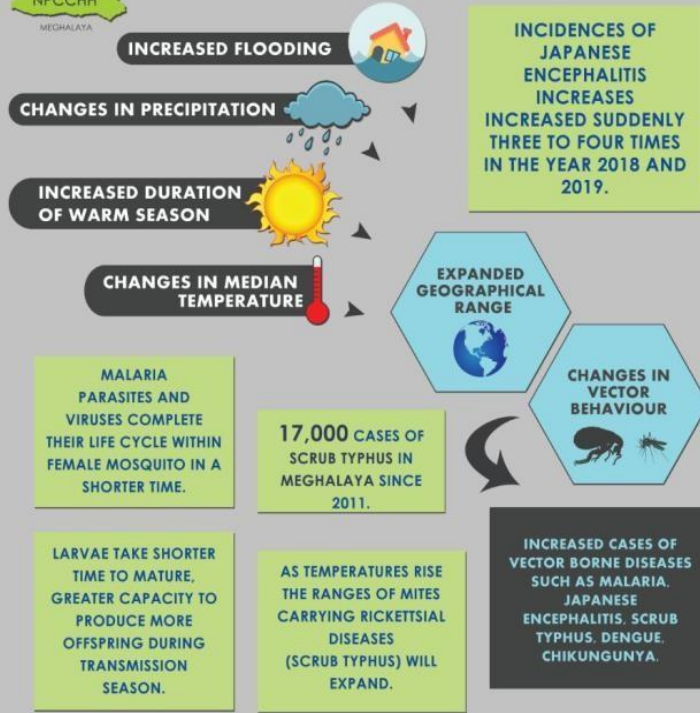

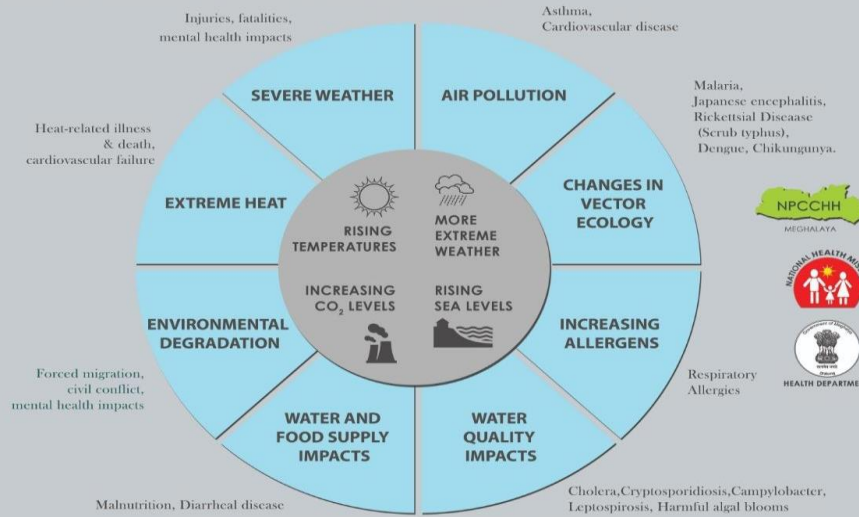

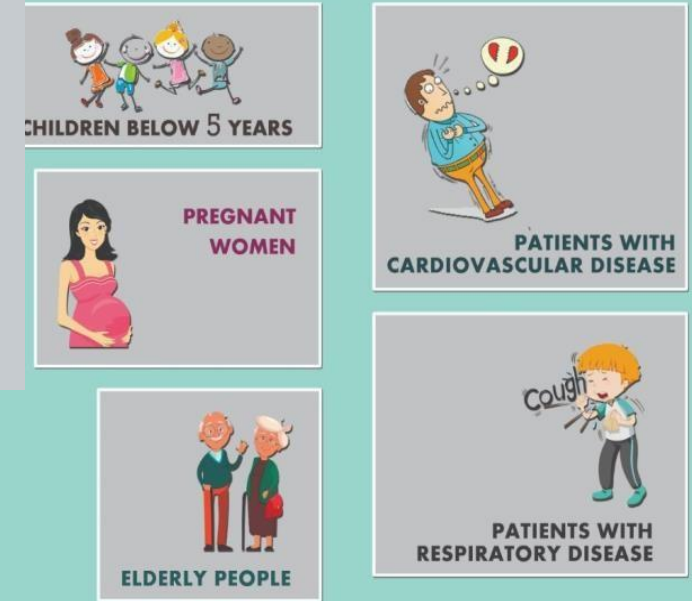
