## **Issue and Challenges**

- State NHM RE is very limited. NPCCHH is included in NCD Flexipool which is already very congested.
- Challenge is to incorporate 'climate' sensibility in all programmes as eventually activities for adaptation and mitigation require action at all levels and all interventions – this will reduce duplication.



## \* Special Achievements \*

- Mizoram was the first state to prepare State Action Plan for Climate Change and Human Health in 2018-19 before NPCCHH programme was included under NHM
- Mizoram Government EF&CC department has included Health Mission as one of the Climate Change missions and included in SAPCC
